Safe Environment Training:

All adults who are working in the Diocese of Victoria with youth at Catholic Schools in classrooms or involved with athletics, Scout leaders, and adult volunteers, youth ministry, Religious Education teachers and aides as well as those adults who come in contact with vulnerable adults when taking Communion to homes are required to complete Safe Environment required before being involved in the noted areas. Training sessions are held frequently throughout the year. Scheduled training session dated may be found on the Diocese of Victoria website at www.victoriadiocese.org. The next scheduled training date at Immaculate Conception is June 14, 2017 for New applicants. An initial Background Check, accomplished online at the Diocese website, must be complete and approved prior to attending SAFE/CPC training. **Re-Certification is required every three years to continue involvement in noted areas** and must be accomplished online at the Diocese of Victoria website.
