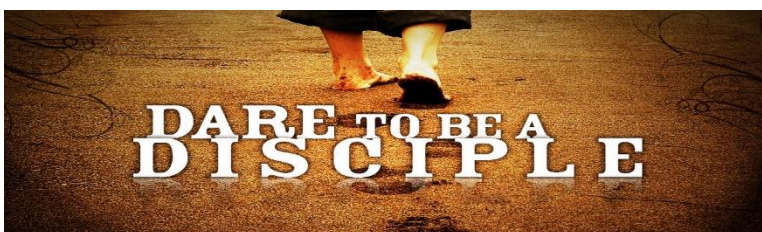

### HOW DID WE COME TO KNOW CHRIST?

In the first reading we are told that God tries to meet people, calls them by name, and makes his voice heard. The Gospel describes the meeting that every person is invited to have with Christ. The second reading tells us of the happy consequences of meeting Christ: a completely new life, a radical change in our way of thinking and acting.

The role of the parent is critical in attending weekly liturgy with your children (Sunday Mass, or the anticipatory Mass Saturday evening), and in overseeing your child's attendance at religious education class. **When attending Mass, ALL Religious Education Students are required to have a weekly bulletin signed by the Pastor, Religious Education Director, or Teacher, and present the bulletin to their Religious Education Teacher at the next Religious Education class. If the student attends mass at another parish other than Immaculate Conception Church, they are to have the "Pastor" of the church they attend sign the bulletin.**
