JESUS, OUR DIVINE HEALER

Jesus came to proclaim liberty to the poor and the outcast. One of his first miracles was to cleanse a leper, thus bringing this outcast back into the life of the Jewish community. With this act Jesus wanted to make known that nobody is to be sent out of, or excluded from, the new family that he has established. This is the theme of the Gospel.

The first reading prepares for the message of the Gospel as it shows us how the Jews treated lepers.

The second reading can be connected to this theme since it tells the Christian community not to look for their own personal interests but to seek the good of all.

Jesus knows our weaknesses, our worries and our burdens. He knows how difficult it is for us to forgive one another and to live in peace as God's children. Yet, he never changes, his compassion for us never changes. We only need to turn to him with trust, and he will fill our hearts with the joy of salvation.
