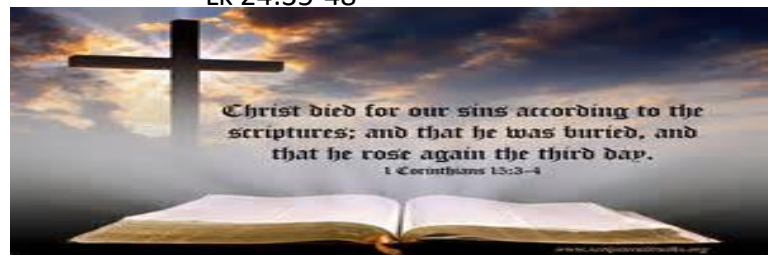

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### "BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO BELIEVE WITHOUT SEEING"

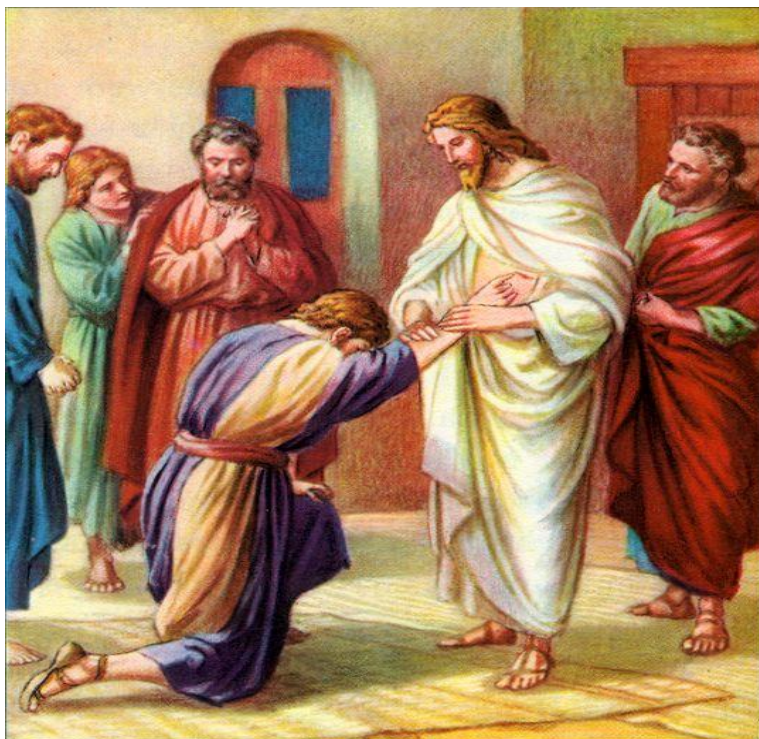
The Gospel today is a continuation of the "First Day" narrative. Last Sunday, Easter Day, we celebrated "morning" and "beginnings". Today we move towards "evening". Mary Magdalene has proclaimed her faith in the risen Lord. We turn now to the story of the eleven. "Late in the day", we use this as an expression when we describe something that happens almost at the last minute.

It would appear from the narrative that the eleven spent the first Easter day behind locked doors, too frightened, by possible violence, to venture out. In the "morning" story, Mary Magdalene goes searching for Jesus. In the "evening" story, Jesus goes searching for his disciples.

The words of Jesus, "Blessed are those who believe without seeing," are quite appropriate for us modern people. Blessed are those who can recognize the voice of the Master in the words resounding every Sunday in the community celebrations.

But people will not be satisfied just with our preaching. They want to see among us a sign, concrete sign, that will prove beyond doubt that the spirit of Christ is at work in the world. The first and the second reading tell us that our brotherly love is the sign that will show unbelievers that we have real faith in the Risen Christ.
