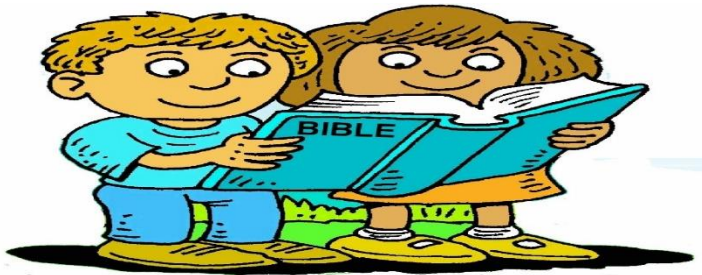

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

WHOEVER REMAINS IN ME WILL PRODUCE MUCH FRUIT

We can produce works that are the fruit of the Spirit only if we remain with Christ. This is the main theme of the Gospel today and is presented through the image of the vine and its branches.

The second reading draws our attention to another point. Our faith is manifested by works of love. These ensure possession of the life of God in ourselves.

The first reading tells us of Paul who, in spite of all difficulties, misunderstandings and suspicions, preserved his union with Christ and with the community of his disciples.

To explain the image of the vine, the vineyard is the Kingdom, the reign of God that Jesus came to inaugurate. The gardener or vinedresser is God, the Father. It is God who plants, prunes, tills and tends the garden.

The true vine is Jesus. He is true because he comes from the one true God. The old vine, Israel, was not true because it was never able to live as God's chosen people, but was always unfaithful.

The branches are the disciples, us, followers of Jesus, called to learn to really love God, ourselves and others. We are pruned by self awareness, by the Word of God that helps us see ourselves as we are, that leads us to repentance and conversion.

What is important here is the inter-relationship between the vine, the branches and the vine dresser. All three are essential for the plant to bear fruit.

The relationship that Jesus has with the Father, and the relationship that Jesus has with us, is crucial for us to bear fruit. It is important that

each member of the church is rooted in Christ and involved in acting out of love as a community. Blessings!

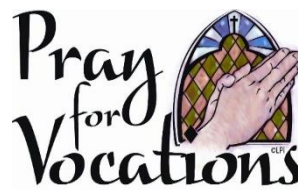
